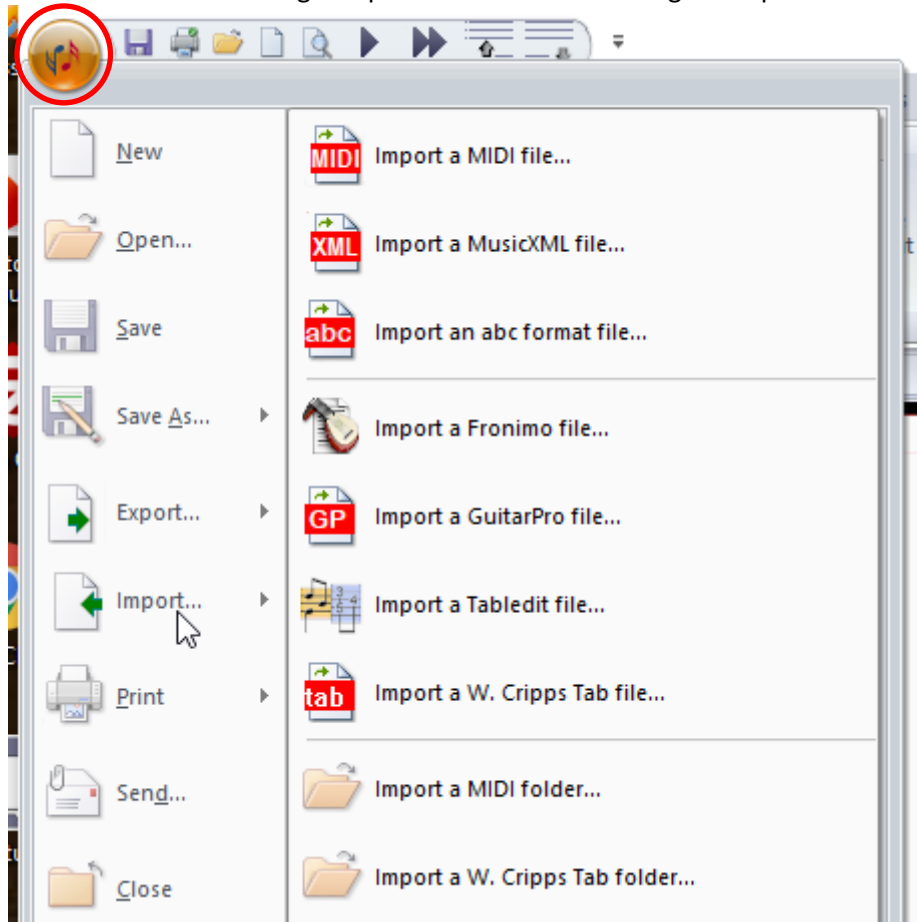


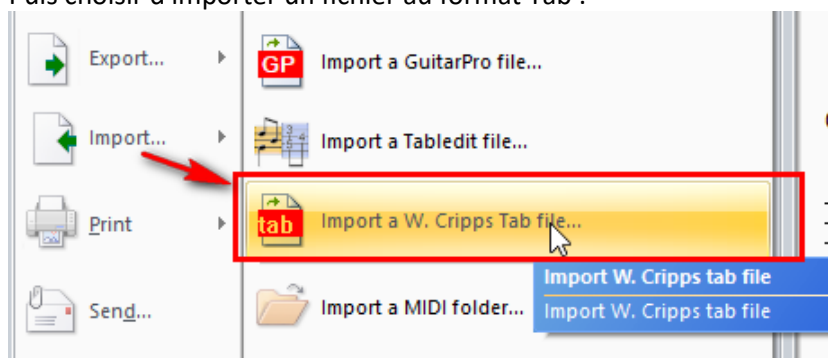
Utilisation fichier .tab dans Fandango

Le fichier .tab n'est utilisable que par la fonction d'importation, de façon à transcrire le format.

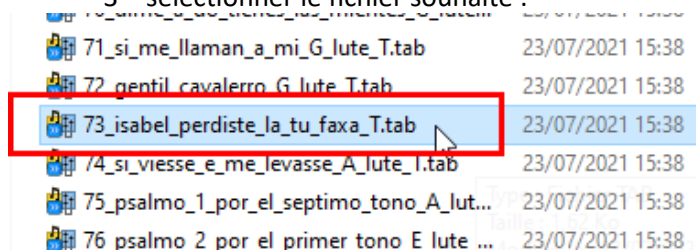
- 1 – extraire le fichier zip contenant toutes les pièces du recueil dans un dossier,
- 2 – dans Fandango cliquer sur l'icône en haut à gauche puis choisir <Import>,



Puis choisir d'importer un fichier au format Tab :



3 – sélectionner le fichier souhaité :



4 – renseigner les informations d'en-tête de la future section :
